- Assist in the recruitment of future contestants
- Keep commitments and be on time
- Develop a platform to raise awareness in citizens of Michigan to the accomplishments of women in wheelchairs, plus all people with a physical disability.
- Be a role model for ALL people with disabilities.
- Identify opportunities to meet with school children so they can better understand persons with disabilities
- Develop your platform and your speech for the national pageant
- Stay involved with the state program after relinquishing your crown
